YOUR STAY ABROAD

According to the §8 Master-Verordnung (MaVo) of the state of Lower Saxony, future teachers of English are obliged to spend 3 months in a country in which English is the official language. The most important requirement is that you immerse yourself in daily English speaking life. With your future career in mind, working in a school is desirable, but not essential – there are many different ways you can immerse yourself in English. You have the freedom to design the experience that suits you best.

DESTINATION ABROAD

The project Destination Abroad has been set up by the Institute of English Studies (IES) to advise you as you make your arrangments. Specifically, we are here to:

- Provide information on the regulations and procedures
- Maintain relationships with our partner institutions and seek new partnership opportunities
- Maintain and improve our website to provide you with the tools to arrange your stay abroad
- Approve your stay abroad plans and issue your completion certificate upon your return

PLAN AHEAD! START WITH THESE QUESTIONS...

— What country do you want to go to?

The English speaking world is large and diverse; there are many countries that have English as an official language, giving you many options from which to choose.

— What do you want to do during your stay?

You should be working, studying or volunteering on a daily basis in an intensely English speaking environment. Ask yourself: do you want to experience the school environment as a teaching assistant, attend an English speaking university, or persue another interest?

— When is the best time during your studies to go?

Your study program leaves very few windows in which you can complete your 3 month stay. For detailed information on the different possibilities, visit our website.

— How will you finance your trip?

Your finances will determine whether you can go near or far, whether you can volunteer or if you need to find a job. There are funding opportunities available, but these require planning ahead!

THE PROCESS

Before the stay abroad

- Find a placement in an English speaking country for a minimum of 3 months
- Fill out the form Agreement Stay Abroad. Book an appointment at the Destination Abroad office to
 discuss your plans and have the form signed to ensure that your placement will be recognised by the
 university.

During the stay abroad

 Get a signed letter of reference from your placement, including arrival and departure dates and confirmation that you were in an English speaking context

Upon your return

- Fill out the online Questionnaire Destination Abroad
- Fill out the Certificate of Completion and book an appointment at the Destination Abroad office to have your certificate signed (bring your Agreement Stay Abroad and letter of reference with you.
- Submit the Certificate of Completion to the Pr
 üfungsservice in order to get your stay abroad
 officially recognised.
