As we are all embedded in various institutions: how can we re/think them and our positions within? Are there ways to subvert them by using their tools in different ways? What are the potentials - and the stakes - of dropping out of institutions, of staying within, or "fucking up" (Valerie Solanas)? With From Where | Stand and Pact of Silence - How to break it?. we have brought together two feminist collaborations who are invested in these questions. In an ongoing collective process between Hamburg, Berlin, Bangalore, and Delhi, we are discussing our roles within existing institutions, new ways of relating, and the (im)possibilities of creating feminist institutions.

How to break it? Institutional critique & insti-tuting otherwise from a feminist perspective Research Training Group "Cultures of Critique is a 4-day workshop From the Leuphana University of Lüneburg ) I Stand held in the context of the meets Pact of Silence A first result of this dialogue is the public talk and 4-day workshop held at Leuphana University in April and May 2021. The public online talk will introduce the work of Pact of Silence -How to break it?, initiated by art historians and curators Arnika Ahldag (Delhi/Bangalore) and Meenakshi Thirukode (Instituting Otherwise, Delhi). Their 4-day online workshop at Leuphana University will, with a limited number of students, dive deeper into ways of dealing with institutions and of instituting otherwise.

The collaborative project Pact of Silence - How to break it? situates itself within histories of feminist consciousness raising and began in a post #metoo landscape within the Indian Art World in 2018 – 19. Via formats that are structured intuitively, and in response to various intersecting factors around political temporalities, gender, sexuality, race, and the institution, Pact of Silence is an attempt at creating "brave spaces" (Micky Scottbey Jones), where working together is imagined in more equitable spaces within the arts. The methods focus on the process of reading, study and transformative as well as restorative practices that centre the speaking out of our truths while holding space for each other.

From Where I Stand started in 2016 as a collaboration between Laura Kowalewski, Oona Lochner, and Isabel Mehl who met in the context of the Research Training Group "Cultures of Critique" at the Leuphana University of Lüneburg. Their initial workshop series "Feminist Art/Writing: Genealogies. Subjectivities, and Critique" invited art historians, art critics, curators, and artists to discuss feminist ways of writing about art. Growing into a collaboration of writing, thinking, and speaking together, FWIS has been joined by Rebecca Hanna John and Nele Wulff, also members of "Cultures of Critique", as well as other voices.
