



MA Gender and Diversity Certificate Seminars – Summer Semester 2026

In order to complete the MA Gender and Diversity Certificate, students are required to complete three seminars. First, **'Introduction to Theories of Gender and Diversity'**, usually taught in the winter semester in the 'Engaging with Knowledge and the Sciences' module in Complementary Studies. Second, a seminar on **gender and/or diversity methods** within the 'Reflecting on Research Methods' module (usually in the summer semester) also within Complementary Studies. Third, in any semester of their studies, students have a **free choice** and can opt to take any seminar offered within the certificate, either from the 'Connecting Science, Responsibility and Society' module in Complementary Studies or within their major.

The following provides an overview of all certificate seminars offered in the 2026 summer semester.

Students enrolled in the MA Gender and Diversity Certificate have the right to enrol early in one seminar within the certificate each semester. **The deadline for early enrolment in 2026 Summer Semester seminars is: 09 March 2026.**
