Career-related information

BERUFENET (www.berufenet.arbeitsagentur.de) is a database of the Employment Agency, which provides full information about tasks and activities, admission requirements, earnings and employment opportunities to prospects and alternatives in more than 3,100 jobs.

General overview of the labour market

The Institute for Employment Research (*German abbreviation: IAB*) (www.iab.de) studies the labour market in terms of overall labour market developments, regional and international labour markets, labour market policies, companies and employment, etc. Trends including regional aspects are then drawn from the statistics.

ISA (Information System study choice and labour market) (www.uni-due.de/isa/) aims at producing a clear and appropriate register of results from labour market research for a special classification and evaluation in order to provide a high degree of orientation possibilities.
