



Summary

- In the Leuphana semester a total of 5 modules are to be taken, 3 interdisciplinary and 2 discipline-specific

- Attention, the course registration does not automatically include the registration for the examination, this must be done via qis, registration deadline is 15.11.2021.
- The official basis for the creation of the schedule is <u>appendix 5</u>
- The appendix offers a clear list of all courses and examination forms to be taken.
- The assignment to the myStudy courses takes place in two lotteries. At the end of the second lottery, all remaining places will be released for immediate registration.
