Have translations made if your certificates are not in German or English. **Get certified copies.** Submit your transcripts in the original language - and additionally in German or English translation. This also applies to your module handbooks and transcript of records.
Please note: The translations **must be** done by a **sworn translator in Germany**. Self-made translations or translations by simple translation agencies without a sworn translation will **not** be accepted.
