For SoSe, the classification is only made in even semesters and for WiSe only in odd semesters. For a classification into the 2nd semester 20 CPs of creditable achievements are required, for the 3rd semester 40 CPs, for the 4th semester 60 CPs and so on. If the corresponding number of creditable CPs is available, it may be advisable to apply for several subject semesters.	

1. Get information in advance

Have translations made if your certificates are not in German or English. Get certified copies. Submit your transcripts in the original language - and additionally in German or English translation. This also applies to your module handbooks and transcript of records.

Please note: The translations **must be** done by a **sworn translator in Germany.** Self-made translations or translations by simple translation agencies without a sworn translation will **not** be accepted.
