STUDY TRACK "INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS, SUSTAINABILITY AND GOVERNANCE"

- Application deadline:
 - Applications close (for International self-funding applications): 25 July 2022
 - Applications close (for UK/EU self-funding applications): 31 August 2022
- Entry requirements:
 - 2.1 Honours degree or non-UK equivalent in law. We also consider applications from other subjects, such as Politics, International Relations, European Studies or War Studies, if at least 50% of the credits are in law.
 - English language qualifications
- Fees:
 - Please note that there are tuition fees for this programme. For further information please visit the website of the <u>consortium</u>.



ERASMUS MUNDUS SCHOLARSHIPS

The Erasmus Mundus scholarship includes:
