



## CONSECUTIVE SUBJECTS

The listed requirements are based on the assumption of a Bachelor degree programme of at least 180 CP (ECTS). If your university does not use the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), you have to demonstrate that your Bachelor degree programme was composed either of at least two relevant disciplines, each representing 1/6 of your total programme (2 x 30 Credit Points [CP] = 60 CP of 180 CP) or of one relevant discipline representing 1/3 of your total programme (1 x 60 CP of 180 CP). **Exception:** For the *Work & Organizational Psychology* programme, applicants have to demonstrate at least **70 CP in psychology subjects and at least 30 CP in research methods and statistics.**
