



Overview of Outstanding Consecutivity (40 » 60 CP)

Due to the Corona pandemic the application regulations of the Leuphana Graduate School have been adjusted. At least 2*20, or 40 (instead of 2*30, or 60) Credit Points of subject-relevant modules need to be completed upon application to prove consecutivity. This proof has to be shown by a certified Transcript of Records and possibly module descriptions. **Until March 31st 2021 the completion of 60 subject-relevant Credit Points needs to be proven.**

If you cannot prove 60 Credit Points of subject-relevant modules at the time of application, you have to additionally enclose this form with your application documents. The form should display the modules which you are going to complete and use for fulfilling the missing Credit Points to reach 60 Credit Points for consecutivity.
