Application process

- All applications for the ILGSPD programme and Erasmus Mundus scholarships <u>must be submitted online to the University of</u> <u>Glasgow</u>
- Application Deadlines:
 - Scholarship applications 12 January 2024 (you must include all required documents and proof of English language proficiency]
 - Applications close (for International self-funding applications): <u>July 2024</u>
 - Applications close (for UK/EU self-funding applications): <u>2024</u>
- Required documents: official degree certificate(s), official academic transcript(s), two reference letters, Evidence of your English
 Language ability (if your first language is not English), Copy of the passport, CV, Scholarship form or Personal statement and
 pathway preference form
- Fees: Please note that there are tuition fees for this program. For further information please visit the website of the consortium.

Erasmus Mundus Scholarships



The Erasmus Mundus scholarship includes:

- a contribution to the student participation costs (including tuition fees, full insurance coverage and any other mandatory costs related to the student's participation in the EMJMD study program
- a contribution to student travel and installation costs
- a monthly subsistence allowance for the entire duration of the EMJMD study program.

Application:

- Applications close for Erasmus Mundus scholarship students: <u>12 January 2024.</u>
- Erasmus Mundus Scholarship: <u>Application possible for all students</u>
- Assignment follows regional quota
- Assessment criteria:
 - Academic merit, relevance and degree of academic qualifications 50%
 - Personal statement of motivation and research interests 30%
 - Quality of academic references -10%
 - Other (relevant research/ professional experiences or interests) 10%

The Erasmus Mundus Master in International Law of Global Security, Peace and Development (ILGSPD) is designed to train the next-generation of lawyers and policy-makers with the ability to navigate the political context of international law, and the comprehensive knowledge needed to engage with the issues of global security, peace and development.

The world is facing unprecedented, complex and interconnected challenges. With increasing violence due to armed conflicts, terrorism and violent extremism, deepening socioeconomic fragility and inequality, massive flows of refugees, climate change, and the development of new technologies like cyber technologies and Artificial Intelligence, the contemporary world order appears to be increasingly destabilized.
