


#### // INTERNATIONALISATION@HOME (IaH)


- Universities recognize the importance of expanding student learning to include global, international and intercultural competencies (Soria & Troisi, 2014, p. 262)
- laH as an answer to the insight that not all students can go abroad (Bruhn, 2020)
- laH is "the purposeful integration of international and intercultural dimensions into formal and informal curriculum for all students within domestic learning environments" (Beelen & Jones, 2015, p.69)



#### **Lessons learned**

- Create value for every partner

- Use appropriate (virtual) teaching and learning approaches
- Essential for success is the support of virtual facilitators

#### **Current challenges**

- Limited interest and motivation to establish new cooperations
  - Various barriers of int. cooperations
  - Individual (e.g., language proficiency)
  - Tecnical (e.g., data protection regulation)
- Institutional (e.g., administrative support at partner unis)
- Consolidation of the cooperations
