

FOR A POSTDOC FELLOWSHIP TO FOCUS ON YOUR RESEARCH

We invite you to come to Leuphana University of Lüneburg as a postdoctoral fellow, using one of the following options:

- You have already acquired a scholarship, funded e.g. by the German Research Foundation (DFG) or Alexander von Humboldt Foundation (AvH). You are now looking for an inspiring place that serves as a host institution.
- You and Leuphana jointly develop your project application for e.g. DFG or AvH schemes.
- You apply for one of our Leuphana postdoc scholarships modelled on DFG and AvH standards. Your experience and family situation will be reflected in the scope of the scholarship, which can run for up to two years.

We generally welcome fellows in all our areas of research. Leuphana scholarships in particular are available in the following areas:



ENJOYWORKING AT A GREEN AND SUSTAINABLE UNIVERSITY

Leuphana's campus, characterized by its historical military architecture, has been converted into a vibrant and green space for learning, research, and meeting old and new friends. The central building, designed by architect Daniel Libeskind in cooperation with students, encourages to take new perspectives through its distinct shapes on the out- and inside.

But it is not only the campus that is green (and even climate-neutral since 2014). Leuphana's School of Sustainability, founded in 2011, was the first of its kind in Germany and contributes to the university's research profile ever since. Even below faculty level, many student initiatives focus on making Leuphana even more sustainable.
