



NOTES FOR STUDENTS FOR THE CONDUCT OF PRESENCE EXAMINATIONS

in compliance with the requirements for combating the corona pandemic

LEGALLY NON BINDING – PLEASE REFER TO THE GERMAN VERSION FOR A LEGALLY BINDING VERSION

For your protection against COVID-19 disease and to protect others, the University has designed the testing procedures to minimize the risk of droplet, aerosol and smear infections. For the implementation of the protection concept we are dependent on your assistance. We ask you to observe the following rules:

1. Arrival and departure

You are responsible for organising your arrival and departure for the examination. When travelling to and from the examination, please observe the distance, contact and quarantine regulations of the country/countries you are travelling to, as well as the hygiene recommendations of the Robert Koch Institute and the Federal Foreign Office.

2. Examination room

On the way to and from examinations, the obligation to wear a medical or FFP2 respirator mask still applies. There is also a strong recommendation to wear a respiratory mask during examinations; however, due to the spacing given during examinations, wearing a mask is not compulsory.

3. Corona-related withdrawal period for students

Withdrawal without stating reasons is possible up to the start in the case of presence examinations if the examinee goes into quarantine at short notice due to an order or voluntarily; non-appearance at the examination is deemed to be a declaration of withdrawal. The Student Services will subsequently document the withdrawal in the digital examination administration. Please seek medical advice in case of symptoms of illness, especially cough, fever, disturbance of the sense of smell and/or taste, cold, sore throat, shortness of breath, headache and pain in the limbs, loss of appetite, weight loss, nausea, abdominal pain, vomiting, diarrhoea, conjunctivitis, skin rash, swelling of the lymph nodes, apathy, somnolence. Please do not come to the examination if you have been diagnosed with an illness by a doctor.

4. Risk groups

Students who, for corona-related reasons, cannot take an examination in a room with other persons for proven medical reasons (medical certificate), even taking into account the university's hygiene concept, can also take their examination in another room as an infection protection measure within the scope of the spatial and organisational possibilities. 5. Health impairments

Please note that in cases of illness not related to corona, the requirements of the relevant framework examination regulations for withdrawal apply. You are therefore welcome to use the University's declaration of withdrawal due to illness-related inability to take examinations.
