WRITING TUTOR TRAINING

As a writer of academic texts, you constantly have to make tough decisions. How do I cite this source? Is this a proper paraphrase? How do I develop a research question? What is the difference between a research paper and an essay? How do I complete three (or more) writing projects this term? We can help you to find answers to these questions, to make the right decisions, and to develop as a writer. Meet with us in a one-on-one session, even if you do not have a text (yet). We work with writers on texts written in English or German and across all levels and disciplines. If you have already started on your projects, we are happy to provide feedback on work-in-progress.

DROP-IN SESSIONS (GERMAN AND ENGLISH)

Do you want to know how a one-on-one consultation works? Do you have a specific question (perhaps one that prevents you from making the kind of progress you expected)? If that is the case, stop by during one of our drop-in sessions!

INDIVIDUAL CONSULTATION

In one-on-one sessions, we focus on you and your specific concerns and needs while also considering all of your linguistic resources. We discuss your ideas, provide feedback on work-in-progress, and identify opportunities for you to improve your text and to develop as a writer. Use our online booking system to schedule an appointment.



Are you interested in writing? Do you enjoy reading and providing feedback on texts? Do you want to learn how to overcome challenges during the writing process and to share these insights with others? If so, register for our writing tutor training. Improve as a writer and acquire pedagogical skills.

The tutor training consists of several modules, which are taught in German and/or English. Complete the required modules in one week (usually right before classes resume in fall or in spring) and elective modules while classes are in session. This training is not part of the curriculum (and you will not receive credit points), but students who completed the training have told us that their participation in the program has given them an edge before and after graduation. You may also apply for a position as a peer writing tutor at our institution if you have completed your training.
