

Teilnahme am “2016 Energy Policy for Bridging and Communications Forum”

Within the framework of the Taiwanese National Energy Program-Phase II (<http://www.nepii.tw/language/en/home-en/>) the “**2016 Energy Policy for Bridging and Communications Forum**” took place on August 19, 2016 in Taipei, Taiwan. The forum featured the law, practice and policy in popular renewable energy countries, with a special focus on offshore wind energy development. Christian Maly (Leuphana University Lüneburg, Germany) provided the participants with an insight of the German energy transition and focused on the German offshore wind energy development. He highlighted different approaches to involve locals in wind energy projects. In this panel, moderated by Chien-Te Fan (National Tsing Hua University, Institute of Law for Science and Technology, Taiwan), Jeremy Mark Firestone (University of Delaware, USA) discussed public participation in wind power siting in the United States. Navraj Singh Ghaleigh (University of Edinburgh, UK) focused on legal and financial considerations for offshore wind projects in the United Kingdom. In the following panels, Asian experts discussed the Taiwanese offshore wind energy case.
