Prof. Dr. Michael Frese of the Institute for Management & Organization of the Leuphana University of Lüneburg is one of Germany's most influential economists, according to the current economist ranking of the Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung (F.A.Z.) in 2017. Prof. Frese is ranked 6th in the category Research Quotes from Economists from Germany, Austria and Switzerland. Looking at only Germany, he is the country's third most cited economist.

The economists' F.A.Z. ranking shows which economic researchers are the most popular in the media, politics, and research. The basis is a database of around 3,000 people. The ranking takes into account the number of quotes from the past years. The data originates from the research database Scopus, the largest quotation and abstract database of the world with 110,000 books and 21,000 magazines. The F.A.Z. analyzed citations from the years 2013 to 2017.

Since 2006, the Handelsblatt has regularly analyzed the research performance of economists working in German-speaking countries. The database is based on the publications of 3,000 researchers. The Handelsblatt ranking is based on internationally established standards for the evaluation of economic research. Research institutes of the ETH Zurich and the University of Düsseldorf analyze the data according to guidelines of the newspaper.

Since August 2009, Michael Frese has been working as a professor for psychology at Entrepreneurship and Innovation at Leuphana. His research interests are also there. He is well known inter alia for his longitudinal research on psychological effects of unemployment, stress effects in work and his field studies on error culture. Further, his large-scale studies on poverty reduction in developing countries through an improved entrepreneurial mindset have attracted much attention.
