

4th Summer School on Sustainable Chemistry

Lüneburg. From 24 September 2018 until 29 September 2018 the 4th Summer School on Sustainable Chemistry for Sustainable Development will take place at the Leuphana University of Lüneburg in Germany. This year the challenges and advantages of chemistry for a sustainable habitation and construction will be the main focus of the school. Participants will develop strategies to optimize the usage of chemical products in this field as well as elaborate possible approaches and solutions.

The example of construction materials and materials for habitation will help to examine prerequisites, opportunities and limits within this scope of application.
