

2018 Award for distinguished scientific contributions to the international advancement of applied psychology for Michael Frese

Established in 1994, the IAAP Distinguished Scientific Contributions Award recognizes "demonstrated international scientific impact". It is given to a candidate who has made distinguished scientific contributions to the field of applied psychology that have resulted in a better understanding of a psychological phenomenon, and new or improved applications of psychological knowledge in more than one country.

Michael Frese receives the Distinguished Scientific Contributions Award for his dedication to the advancement of the research on multiple domains in organizational psychology, and in particular on personal initiative and entrepreneurship, for extending his research to developing countries in Africa, and for his service to the global research and professional community of organizational psychology, as IAAP President and the Editor of Applied Psychology: An International Review, his countless efforts warrant the presentation of this award.
